Strengths: Socializing, switch activation, exploring new toys.

Challenges: feeding myself, noisy environments, abstract concepts, functioning for extended periods of time.

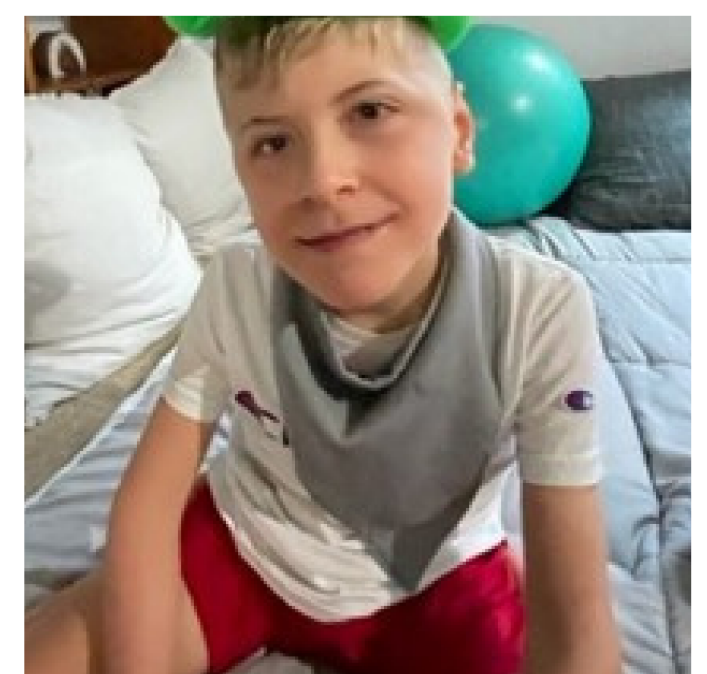


Optimal Learning Environment

Vision-friendly materials and environment, multi-sensory, tactile materials to experience and understand what is being discussed.

Therapy Goals and Needs

AAC Device, physical mobility, play skills, fine motor, use optimal positioning and supported seating, allow warm up time, use consistent language and motivating objects.



Non-Verbal Communication

Facial expressions, vocalizations, looking to/reaching for objects, taps at/on object, kicks legs when excited, looking away when not interested, arches back to protest.
